



PeaceJam TEACHER/ADULT TRAINING WORKSHOP

Connect to a global network of youth, adults, and Nobel Peace Prize Winners who are working together to create positive change in their communities, themselves, and the world!

WHAT: The PeaceJam Foundation along with Excel Youth Zone is excited to offer a one-day training on our PeaceJam service-learning curriculum programs. These comprehensive programs give you and the young people you work with the ability to affect change in your community and to meet* and spend the weekend with a Nobel Peace Prize Winner! (*Leaders and Ambassadors programs only)

WHO: The training is for classroom teachers, after-school providers and other adults who are new to PeaceJam or experienced with PeaceJam and are interested in connecting with youth through this unique and dynamic program.

WHEN: Saturday, December 5th, 2009 • 8:00am-3:30pm

WHERE: T.B.D. (San Diego location)

COST: \$225.00 for two from same organization/\$200.00 for single registrant***NOTE: Fee includes meals, one set of curriculum, videos, online resources, and training. Choose from one of these age-appropriate curricula:

PeaceJam Juniors Curriculum – Elementary School: is an exciting program for ages 5 to 11 that introduces young students to the lives and work of Nobel Peace Laureates in an age-appropriate, standards-based format. It is designed as a stand-alone curricular unit or as a complement to existing curricula or programs such as Character Education, Conflict Resolution, Service-Learning, Citizenship and Multicultural Education.

PeaceJam Leaders Curriculum – Middle School: is a new standards-based curriculum for young people between the ages of 11 and 14. It explores the adolescent stories of 12 Nobel Peace Laureates and the strategies they used to overcome problems in their lives and their communities. Through this age-appropriate curriculum, youth explore their own identities and reexamine the choices they make including their role models and the peer groups to which they belong. Youth also develop leadership and problem-solving skills while engaging in service-learning activities that address local needs.

PeaceJam Ambassadors Curriculum – High School: is designed for youth ages 14-19 and explores issues related to peace, violence, social justice and oppression. Youth study the lives and work of 12 Nobel Peace Laureates and the strategies they use to address pressing global issues. Participating youth create and implement their own Global Call to Action Projects, becoming creative leaders who are committed to solving the most difficult problems facing our world. The program also includes an annual PeaceJam Youth Conference where youth spend a weekend with a Nobel Peace Laureate giving them an unprecedented opportunity to share with, learn from, and be inspired by a world leader for peace.
