Service Learning Workshops

Excel Youth Zone will train educators on how to add a service learning component in their classroom or afterschool setting. Service learning can be added to an existing or new curriculum to meet grade level and subject content requirements and youth development goals. Excel Youth Zone will advise on accessing resources and strategies to conduct high quality service-learning.

Service Learning Coaching

Excel Youth Zone staff will meet with you throughout the stages of your service-learning project to advise on the curriculum, connection to the community and process, goals and outcomes. Excel Youth Zone staff will provide materials, research and interactive support to enhance the service-learning experience for students and educator. Excel Youth Zone will serve as the point of contact between educator and the outside community organization serving as the project site.

Out-of-School Coordination

Choose to contract with Excel Youth Zone to be the providers of high-quality, afterschool service-learning club coordination at your site. Excel Youth Zone coordinators will provide materials, research, supervision of activities to implement our successful afterschool service-learning program, Club XYZ. Excel Youth Zone coordinators are available for service projects with youth during out-of-school hours, evening hours and Saturdays as based on the needs of the service project, youth and community.

Service Learning Recognition

Excel Youth Zone is a certified organization for youth service hours. Each student, age 5-14, participating in 25 hours or more of service can be nominated by Excel Youth Zone to receive the “Governor and First Lady’s Volunteer Service Award” from the State of California. Any youth involved with Excel Youth Zone, K-12, serving 50 or more hours can be nominated for the “Presidential Volunteer Service Award” from Washington D.C. **(\$5.00 per youth for Presidential Award only)**
